between the migrant workers and their Taiwanese employers. The employers are eager to flex their recently acquired financial muscle; many are first-generation career women as well as first-generation employers. The domestics are recruited from abroad as contract and "guest" workers; restrictive immigration policies prohibit them from seeking permanent residence or transferring from one employer to another. They care for Taiwanese families' children, often having left their own behind. Throughout *Global Cinderellas*, Lan pays particular attention to how the women she studied identify themselves in relation to "others"—whether they be of different classes, nationalities, ethnicities, or education levels.
